My Site Has Been Migrated to ByteHouse. How Do I Test Functionality Before Re-pointing DNS?

If you've moved a website to ByteHouse from your previous host, you want to test it to see if it works before making the switchover.

Your Plesk control panel offers a "site preview" link which will allow you to test the majority of websites, however, for some sites built in Wordpress, Joomla, Magento etc "site preview" may not be a suitable tool.

To test fully, ByteHouse recommends editing your local host's file on your workstation. To do this follow these instructions;

On a Windows PC;

1. Click START>>ALL PROGRAMS>>ACCESSORIES>>
2. Right click mouse on "NotePad"
3. Click "run as administrator"
4. Empty notepad will open.
5. Click FILE>>OPEN
6. Browse to and open the file called HOSTS, located here ;
c:\windows\system32\drivers\etc

With the file open, it will display something like this;

```
# localhost name resolution is handled within DNS itself.  
# 127.0.0.1 localhost  
# ::1 localhost
```

After the last line in the file add the following 2 lines for each domain you are testing and save the file. Replace the bytehouse domain and the IP address with the domain name you want to test and the IP address of the new server;

```
93.91.23.77 bytehouse.co.uk  
93.91.23.77 www.bytehouse.co.uk
```

If the file saves successfully, you will now have told your PC that the website is running on the new server. Just open a fresh browser and visit the domain name you entered in the file. When testing has completed, remember to remove the changes you made to the hosts file.
