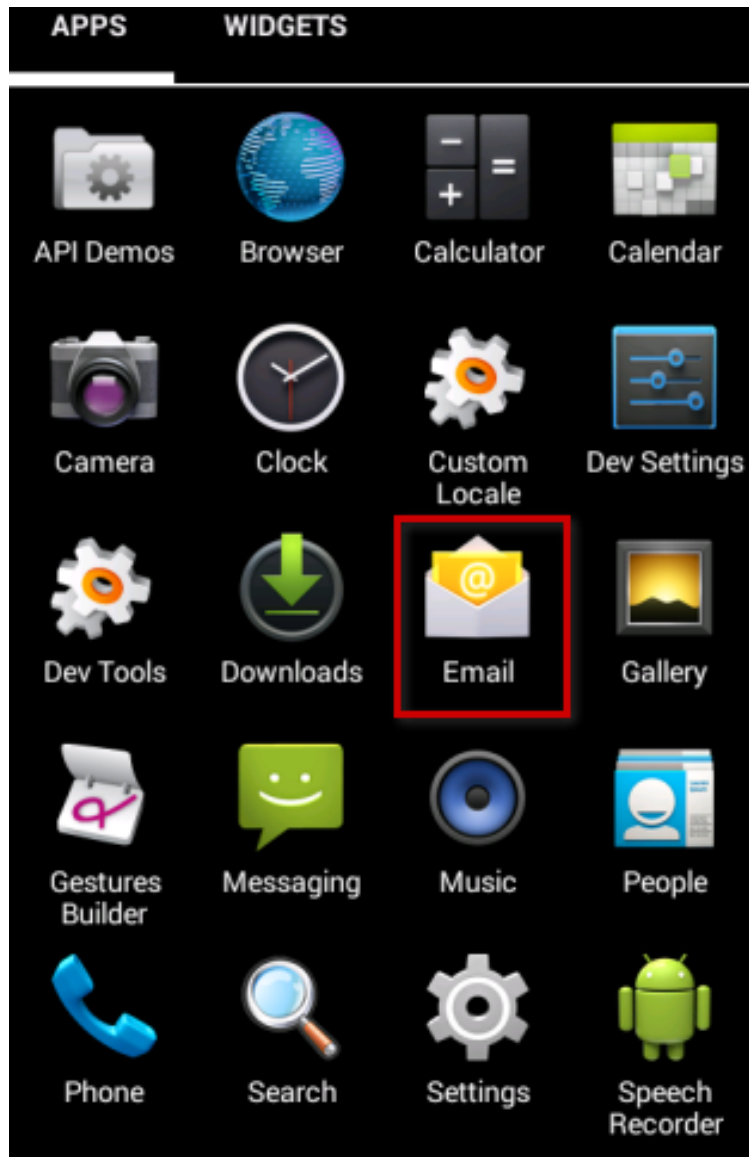

Configuring E-mail account on android phone

You can configure E-mail account on android phone by following the below steps:

1. Select "Email" on your adroid phone.



2. Enter the "email address" and "password" of the new account.




Please note that 'Incoming mail server' & 'Outgoing (SMTP) email server' will be normally 'mail.your_domain.com' for Plesk hosting.

If you have hosted your mails in 'Hosted Exchange' or Icwarp Merak Mail, then SMTP settings will be different.

In case if you are not sure about your SMTP settings, submit a Trouble Ticket to Bytehouse through your ControlCentre or ClientArea.
