## Password Protect Directories in cPanel

### Password Protect Directories in cPanel

This feature allows you to protect certain directories of your account. If you enable this feature, the system prompts users for a username and password when they attempt to view content in a protected folder.

#### To password protect a directory, perform the following steps:

1. Login to WHM.
2. Under security, select "Password Protect Directories".



3. Select the directory that you wish to protect. Click a folder's icon to open it.
4. Select the Password protect this directory checkbox.

#### Security Settings:

*When a user attempts to access the protected directory through a browser, the site will prompt them to enter a username and password. The name that you choose for the protected directory will also display.*

5. Enter a display label for the directory in the Name the protected directory text box. This name is only a label for the directory, and you should not confuse it with the directory's actual name.
6. Click Save.
